07/10/2023 The Sanpete County Sheriff's Office is in possession of a large number of guns. The guns range in make, model, caliber, age and style. These guns have been confiscated, turned over to our custody, or they are found property. If you have lost a gun in the Sanpete County area within the last 10 years, or know that your gun has been turned in or confiscated and would like to get the gun back, please contact us as soon as possible. We will check our records and inventory in evidence for any matching description. Any matching guns will be further researched and a BCI background check will be performed on the gun and the claimant. Every attempt will be made to return the gun to the rightful owner under applicable Utah Law. Any guns not claimed after 90 days of this notice will be considered abandoned property and will be destroyed or will be applied to public interest use. Please refer all inquiries or questions to Sergeant Powell.

You must show proof of ownership or provide a detailed description of your property. You must also be able to pass the BCI background check to receive any firearm.
