

Sanpete County Jail Inmate Visitation

Rules of the jail are as follows:

- Visitors are required to wear modest clothing. No shorts. No see-through blouses or shirts, sleeveless, low-cut, or any shirt showing your skin above your waist. This includes approved children. Children of all ages must be fully dressed. Inmates must be in STATE or COUNTY issued clothing.
- Visitors/callers may not use foul, abusive, threatening, or unreasonably loud language.
- Visitors/callers and inmates may not engage in sexually explicit behavior or calls. This includes nudity, sexually explicit conversation, hand gestures, etc.
- Only APPROVED visitors will be allowed on the remote or onsite visit. The APPROVED visitor should be the only person seen on the video call. **ANY AND ALL VISITORS APPEARING ON A REMOTE OR ONSITE VISIT, MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION AND BE APPROVED! NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- No screenshots may be taken of any inmate. No video sharing with inmate during the visit. Visitors are not allowed to show inmate anything on their cell phone or computer during the visit.
- ALL visitors 18 years of age and older need to create their own SECURUS account with a facial recognition photo, valid government ID (driver license, identification card, passport, and wait for approval.
- ALL visitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian for each visit and the Parent or Guardian must sign the Inmate Visitor Application.
- Unrelated minors will NOT BE ALLOWED TO VISIT!
- Onsite visits are restricted to 2 per week.
- You cannot share visits with other inmate's visitors.
- Any inmate or visitor who exposes themselves during visiting will no longer be allowed to visit any inmate at Sanpete County Jail.

Failure to abide by the Sanpete County Jail policy will result in SUSPENSION OF VISITING PRIVILEGES OR CALLS. The first (1st) offense results in a warning. The second (2nd) offense will result in a 2 week suspension. The third (3rd) offense will result in a 1 month suspension. The fourth (4th) offense will result in no more visitation or calls. The OMR committee will decide if both parties are to be suspended or just the approved visitor for the violation of the policy.
