

Notice of Election

2022 Regular General Election

I, Sandy Neill, Sanpete County Clerk, pursuant to provisions of Utah Code, 20A-5-101(2), do hereby give notice to the public that candidates are to be elected for the following offices at the upcoming General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates and local board of education candidates begins on Monday, March 7, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 11, 2022. The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Friday, July 1, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Friday, July 15, 2022. The Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins on Monday, January 3, 2022 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022. Qualified political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for the elective office.

I. Federal

- A. **U.S. Senate.** One (1) Senator for six (6) year term.
- B. **U.S. House of Representatives.** One (1) Representative for a two (2) year term:
 - 1. The Fourth Congressional District consisting of Juab, part of Salt Lake, Sanpete, and part of Utah Counties.

II. State

- A. **State Executive.** The following position will be elected for a two (2) year term to fill the remainder of a vacancy:
 - 1. State Treasurer.
- B. **State House of Representatives.** One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from the 66th state legislative district.
- C. **State Board of Education.** One member for a four (4) year term from the following State School District.
 - 1. District Fourteen (14) is located in Beaver, Carbon, Emery, Grand, Iron, Juab, Sanpete, Sevier, and Utah Counties.
- D. **Local Boards of Education.** Members of local boards of education should be elected as determined by individual school boards or districts. One member for a four (4) year term from each of the following local school districts.
 - 1. North Sanpete School District # four (4), Consists of FTGM, WalM, NSU & SPRU
 - 2. North Sanpete School District # five (5), FRVM & FRVU
 - 3. South Sanpete School District # one (1), Man1M, Man2M, StrM & STRU
 - 4. South Sanpete School District # four (4), EPH2M, EPH3M & MAN3
 - 5. South Sanpete School District # five (5), EPH1M & EPHMNU

III. Judicial

- A. **Supreme Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Justice, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- B. **Juvenile Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Juvenile Court Judges in the Sixth District,

provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period:

1. Sixth Judicial District, consists of Garfield, Kane, Piute, Sanpete, Sevier, and Wayne Counties.

C. **Justice Court.** Any Justice Court judge whose term is expiring shall be subject to an unopposed retention election in the county in which the court is located to which the judge is appointed.

IV. **Sanpete County**

1. County Commissioner Seat A. One member for a four (4) year term.
2. County Commissioner Seat B. One member for a four (4) year term.
3. County Attorney. One for a four (4) year term.
4. County Auditor. One for a four (4) year term.
5. County Clerk. One for a four (4) year term.
6. County Sheriff. One for a four (4) year term.

Lt. Governor or County Clerk: Multi County State Legislative Offices, and Court of Record Retention Offices.

Lt. Governor: Federal Offices, Congressional Offices and Utah Constitutional Offices.
