GENERAL PURPOSE

Performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled duties as needed to assist with carrying out the county weed control program.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the immediate or close supervision of the Weed Control Supervisor.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

None.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Performs tasks necessary for the control of noxious weeds in accordance with the UTah Noxious Weed Act and the Sanpete County Weed Control Rules and Regulations.
- Operates and maintains a variety of equipment such as trucks, ATV's, tractor mower, backhoe, chemical sprayer, trailers, GPS; calibrate and clean spraying equipment; perform preventive maintenance of assigned vehicles and equipment.
- Assists in documenting all herbicide applications; services rendered to property owners; applications made to public properties; prepares and submits daily reports to supervisor.
- Perform operation of complex heavy equipment such as a backhoe and may operate under seasonal conditions.
- Performs finish and technical grader operations.
- Participates in various seasonal projects such as flood maintenance, weed control, sign maintenance, asphalt work, hot patching, tree trimming, cattle guard maintenance, weed control, sign maintenance, snow removal, etc.
- Responsible for mowing weeds on county owned side street right-of-ways with tractor mower.
- Performs tasks that require the use of hand tools and equipment , including picks, shovels, chainsaws, etc.
- Performs related duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Education and Experience:

- a. Graduation or near graduation from a standard senior high school or equivalent;
AND
- b. One (1) year general experience;
OR
- c. An equivalent combination of education and experience.

2. Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Working knowledge of county geography; minor maintenance procedures on motor vehicles and small vehicles; the safe and proper method of handling toxic chemicals; some knowledge of EPA guidelines and regulations.
- Some demonstrable skill in the safe and correct operation of four wheel drive vehicles and all terrain vehicles.
- Ability to follow simple oral and written instructions; read and interpret road maps; perform basic mathematical computations in determining percentages for calibrations and chemical mixing rates; work with the general public communicating effectively in English both verbal and in writing; work safely and responsibility in a potentially hazardous environment.

3. Special Qualifications:

- Must possess a valid Utah Driver License with a clean driving record; a Class "A" Commercial Driver License (CDL) is preferred but not required.
- Must submit to and pass randomly administered drug tests.

4. Work Environment:

- Tasks require a variety of physical activities, generally involving muscular strain, such as walking, standing, stooping, sitting, reaching, and lifting. Aspects of the work require listening, speaking, and seeing.
- Common eye, hand, finger, leg, and foot dexterity exist. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability, discriminating thinking and some creative problem solving.
- Continuous travel in automobile, equipment, or heavy equipment required in job performance.
- Exposure to hazardous materials, chemicals, sunlight and other potentially hazardous environmental conditions. Daily tasks involve manual labor including considerable lifting of weights up to 50 pounds.
- Some daily and severe seasonal aspects of the job pose threats or hazards capable of producing physical injury.
