

# Notice of 2024 Election for UOCAVA Voters

Dear Voter,

Our records indicate that you are a voter covered under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) and are eligible to vote in the upcoming election either by the ballot we send to you or with a federal write-in absentee ballot (FWAB) (Link to online assistant: <https://www.fvap.gov/fwab-privacy-notice>).

The following offices will be filled at the regular General Election to be held in the County of Sanpete on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 (Presidential Preference and Regular Primary Elections, where applicable, will be held March 5 and June 25, 2024 respectively):

- US President / Vice President
- US Senate, 1 seat
- US House of Representatives – District 4, 1 seat
- UT Governor / Lt. Governor
- UT Attorney General
- UT State Auditor
- UT State Treasurer
- UT State Senate - District 27, 1 seat
- UT House of Representatives – District 66, 1 seat
- Judicial Supreme Court, 1 retention seat
- Judicial Court of Appeals, 1 retention seat
- Judicial Sixth District Court, 1 retention seat
- Judicial Justice Court
- Local School Board- NS 1,2 & 3 & SS 2 & 3, 1 seat each
- County Commissioner, Seat C, 1 seat
- County Assessor
- County Recorder
- County Treasurer

When using a federal write-in absentee ballot for this year's election, you will need to use the Non-federal offices section of the ballot. You will write-in the office and candidate name for the races you choose to vote for. An updated list will be posted on the Sanpete County Election Website at the link above after the candidate filing periods have concluded.

Electronic ballots must be received in the Elections Office by 8:00 pm (Mt. Standard time) on Election Day. Mailed ballots must be postmarked no later than the day **BEFORE** Election Day and be received in office prior to the Election Canvass.
