



Wildland Fire Mitigation Introduction & Guide

Sanpete County Building Dept. 160 North Main, Suite 201 Manti UT. 84642.

Submitting the WUI Permit application and Wildland Interface Mitigation plan. This fee consists of a (\$1000 paid in conjunction with building permit) \$500 Mitigation fee and a \$500 refundable performance deposit. \$500 performance deposit will be refunded if you are eligible. Application and Mitigation plan forms are found on the online permit.

Conditions for eligibility of refund.

- Building project and WUI mitigation must be complete within 36 months of date of building permit issuance. A six month extension is possible with written approval from the building department.
- Project is to remain vacant until permitted to occupy.
- Applicant has a Certificate of Occupancy from the County Building Department.

Steps for application and completion

- Complete your (WUI) Wildland Urban Interface application and attach to building permit online application.
- Complete your Wildland Fire Mitigation Plan. Attach to online application. (must be approved before building permit is issued)
- Schedule an onsite inspection prior to issuance of the building permit, to verify site requirements and defensible space requirements with the WUI inspector.
- Completion of the defensible space requirements must be completed prior to Final Certificate of Occupancy of the structure.
